Mayor's Youth Council Meeting MINUTES

Roll Call

1. Consideration to approve Mayors Youth Council Minutes
 - a. Approve Regular Mayors Youth Council Minutes, April 26, 2018

Youth Council President Abel moved to approve Youth Council Minutes from April 26, 2018. Motion Carried 3-1.

2. Distribute flyers calling for new members to have council hang up and hand out – Jake Lorentz, Parks Department

Jake Lorentz, Parks Department, explained the addition of Council President Abel's name to the flyer and distributed 20 copies to be displayed where the Youth Council deemed appropriate. Mr. Lorentz informed the Council if they needed more they could just request more and they did not have to wait for the next meeting.

3. Request for Mayor's Youth Council to sponsor a movie night for Movies on the Greenbelt 2018 – Jesse Morfin, Parks Department

Jesse Morfin, Parks Department, presented the Mayor's Youth Council a copy of the sponsorship flyer for the Movies on the Greenbelt to suggest a possible sponsorship for the council to get information about the council out to the public. The council agreed to table this until the next meeting so they could have time to look over the information.

Mr. Morfin also presented the plan to build a dock at the Sego Prairie Pond by an Eagle Scout. This project was more than the Eagle Scout believed his troop could raise for the project. The Youth Council was asked to sponsor \$850.00 of the project.

Youth Council moved to sponsor \$850.00 of the proposed Eagle Scout dock at Sego Prairie Pond. Motion carried 4-0.

4. Update on new benches – Youth Council Members

Jake Lorentz, Parks Department, shared none of these had been finished yet, but Mr. Lorentz spoke with the machine shop and they would be completed soon.

5. Appoint new Secretary – Youth Council Members

Council Member Hudon and Council Member Rousseau were nominated for Admin Secretary.

Youth Council moved to elect a new Admin Secretary. Youth Council Member Trystan Rousseau voted in as Admin Secretary. Motion carried 3-1.

6. Mayor/Youth Council/Staff Announcements

Jake Lorentz, Parks Department, advised the Council that he would try to get Fabiola Giddings from the Clerk's Office to come do a presentation about the possibility of a mixer event and possible table at spring registration for new members.

Youth Council Vice President DeHaven suggested doing a bake sale for fund raising at the Kuna Days event in August. This would require the Youth Council to have a booth at the event.

Mayor Stear stated that the City is allotted a booth each year for the Kuna Days event and there would be a possibility to allow the Youth Council to use it for a sale.
