The Kuna Arts Commission (KAC) will begin monthly **Create n Sip** events scheduled for the third Thursday of the month.

The Commission will have local Artists and Crafters instructors of all mediums to join and hope to hold them in a variety of locations within Kuna. These are intended to be fun events for participants to learn how to create a piece of art while “sipping” a beverage.

- Establishments would be listed in the promotion of each class as students are given the opportunity of registering.
- The classes will occur at local Kuna establishments as scheduled by the Commission.
- The City, on behalf of the Commission will pay a per student price to have 1 alcoholic beverage or 2 non-alcoholic beverages. Choice and price is determined in advance.
- The City, on behalf of the Commission will pay a per student price for establishment cleaning. Price is determined in advance.
- Optional: The City, on behalf of the Commission will pay a per student price for snack item (chip/salsa etc). Choice and price is determined in advance.
- Establishment must be able to accommodate 20 or more students plus an instructor.
- Table environments work well and classroom setting is not needed.
- Establishments must be in compliance with any City, County or State licensing requirements.
- Students are welcome to purchase additional beverages or food items from the hosting establishment. The hosting establishment is welcome to have menus or lists available in the area of the class.
