



Comprehensive process – promoted meaningful, inclusive and ongoing communication with stakeholders





Multiple Funding Sources for Phase 1




 - Lighting, landscaping




Project Phasing

We are starting on the west end for a couple of reasons:

- The area drains from east to west. By starting on the west end, we will be able to install drainage facilities on the west / lower end with the first phase to avoid having to tear up the pavement twice
- We want to build on and tie into the Avenue E Sidewalks, Gateway Project, Enrique's, and the Greenbelt Trailhead





Drainage



The new drainage system will meet current ACHD requirements and address drainage issues.




Sidewalks




Sidewalks will be widened from 10' to 16' to provide adequate space for pedestrian-scaled lighting, address cracks, ADA approaches that don't meet slope.




Pedestrian-scale Lighting



Lighting will be placed in the new wider sidewalk area, improving safety and visibility.



Pavement/Roadway




We are working closely with ACHD to determine the most cost-effective solution to address pavement/roadway issues. Our goal is to find the best way to strengthen the pavement section and match the curb and gutter with the new grade of the sidewalk.






Irrigation/Landscaping/Trees/ Flower Pots

Irrigation water will be extended and new trees and landscaping will be planted between businesses for better visibility. This will also provide shade which doesn't currently exist, making it much more pleasant and tolerable during the summer months.



Traffic Calming/Bulb-outs



The bulb-outs will decrease the crossing distance between intersections, making it safer for pedestrians to cross Main Street. The new ADA ramps and bulb-outs will also slow traffic down, making it safer for kids, elderly folks, and patrons walking around downtown.




Community-Supported Design

- Incorporating community themes (Kuna Caves, Water Tower, Birds of Prey, etc.) into the project design.
- Involve local artists in the process to determine how best to do this.
- We envision giving each block a theme. Eventually, art and signage would be added to the new streetscape to make it fun and educational for visitors and the community.
