City of Kuna Recognized with City Achievement Award

BOISE – The Association of Idaho Cities (AIC) recognized the City of Kuna with a City Achievement Award on June 11 during the AIC Virtual Annual Conference June 10-12, 2020.

Idaho city officials are creative, innovative, and solution oriented. The City Achievement Awards recognize the work of cities around Idaho that have implemented pioneering approaches to improve quality of life, address community challenges, and enhance service delivery in cost-effective ways. This year, awards were given in five categories: Community Engagement, Economic & Community Development, Parks & Recreation, Public Safety, and Public Works & Transportation.

The City of Kuna was recognized with a City Achievement Award in the Parks & Recreation Category for its Splash Pad project. A 3,100 square foot splash pad located on the Kuna greenbelt with a system for recycling water and reusing it for irrigation, this has proven to be a very popular summer community amenity.

The Association of Idaho Cities was formed in 1947 and is a nonpartisan, nonprofit corporation organized to serve Idaho's 200 incorporated cities. AIC influences policies and provides education, training and technical assistance to strengthen the ability of city elected officials and staff to serve their communities.
