2. Confirmation on the commission schedule to meet (which Thursday of the month?)
Commission agreed to meet the 2nd Thursday of the month @ 5:45pm

3. Discuss timelines:
 - a. Update from subcommittee for the Public Art policy recommendation for Council
 - *Commissioner Fisher has emailed other cities for ideas, Commissioner Fisher and Commissioner Zarr will provide and collaborate a draft for March's meeting*
 - b. Mission Statement
Commissioner Soldano & City staff will collaborate a final draft for March's meeting
 - c. Bylaws-A new committee member is needed-
Commission agreed to let City staff do a rough draft for March's meeting, we can put a call out for new members

4. Establish art calls and rotations for display at City Hall-Currently there is no art in City Hall
 - *The Commission agreed on a 90 day rotation, the criteria is any medium-Black & White displays.*
 - *The Commission would also like a meet and greet in public with the artists for each rotating period starting in April 2017*
 - *City staff will issue the call for art to be displayed*
 - *Commission agreed to put a slide show of the art displays to get the community together*

5. Determine how to invite Public participation in projects and what level of input at meetings
 - The Commission supports all public projects, meetings and events*
 - a. Involving Artists in Kuna, not on the board but are willing to share knowledge
 - The Commission encourages all of Kuna's Artists*

6. Update from subcommittee for Downtown fundraising and Arts Commission fundraising potential partnership for May 19 and May 20 Art Show on the Greenbelt, artist, crafters, music, performances, food vendors
 - *The Commission agreed to a space fee of \$25.00 for Kuna Artist & Crafters within the Kuna School District boundaries*
 - *A \$50.00 fee for outside of Kuna School District boundaries*
 - *A 80/20 split and a \$10.00 credit for artists & crafters*
 - *A flat fee of \$75.00 for Kuna School District boundaries food vendors*
 - *A \$125.00 for outside of Kuna School District boundaries food vendors*
 - *Commission will consider Best Sellers for future Kuna events*
 - *Entertainment is free, but performers can have a tip jar*
 - *Agreeable for City staff to call out for volunteers for planning and implementing the event*

7. Discuss Hispanic Cultural event-additional subcommittee members needed
 - *Commission agreed on event being in July and to put a call out for volunteers*
 - *Commissionaire Soldano, Commissionaire Paz, Enrique Contreras, Debbie Crossley & City staff will be assisting*
