1. Update on the Public Art policy recommendation for City Council - Commissioner Fisher & Commissioner Zarr

Commissioner Fisher and Commissioner Zarr discussed several options they have reviewed. They will put a version together for the commission's review.

City Clerk Chris Engels reminded Commissioners that the Policy Ordinance needs to be completed before going to council for the funding request they want to make between May-June 2017.

Commissioner Zarr mentioned that the Arts Commission should ask for 1.33%,

Commissioner Fisher said maybe ask for 1% instead of 1.33%.

All Commissioners are interested in doing fundraisers, (example: silent auction, or buy a bowl like the food bank, call out for painted chairs, dinner with the Mayor at Enrique's)
