1. Vote for Chair, Vice Chair & Secretary

2. Update for Downtown and Arts Commission partnership for July 8, 2017 Art Show. – City Clerk, Chris Engels

Commissioner Sharon Fisher moved to set a 25% refund on attended vendors table fees, since we closed early due to the heat, seconded by Commissioner Seamons, Motion carried 5-0

Chair Zarr discussed how all commissioners need to volunteer more time to the events and asking the community for volunteers for future events. Commissioner Fisher would like more promotions on events.

City Clerk Chris Engels discussed the possibility of central check out for future events, to get more vendors that don't need to worry about credit cards. Chair Zarr discussed looking into an ATM machine for events.

City Clerk Chris Engels discussed the possibility of the food vendors from the Art Show at an event to take public input on the Bernie Fisher parking lot if a pending grant funds.

City Clerk Engels, also mentioned the Art Grant for Ave E for an art alley for interaction. A replica of the Kuna water tower would be displayed in the alley.

3. Create n Sip-cost and supplies/Kuna Event Center

All Commissioners agreed to the 3rd Thursday of every month to hold a class and to rotate locations throughout Kuna. Commissioners also agreed to call it Create n Sip. Staff will get calls for locations and instructors out.
