WHEREAS, Anne was hired as the Library Director for Kuna Library District in 1993, she worked closely with the Kuna School District to maintain a shared library for both students and library patrons.

WHEREAS, in 1993, with Anne at the helm and the strong support of the community, district residents built a 12,500 square foot library. The new library building opened in the summer of 1999. Starting with 7,000 volumes, the library has grown to over 85,000 volumes; and

WHEREAS, Anne has been acknowledged by various local and regional groups throughout her career for the outstanding quality of her work and, in 2015, August 9th was proclaimed Anne Hankins Day in Kuna, Idaho; and

WHEREAS, Anne is retiring in 2017 as Kuna's first library director. She has been and continues to be a tremendous gift to the people of Kuna.
