

**RE:** Energy and Cost Savings in Sewer Department

Mayor and Council,

I wanted to point out the significant savings I have noticed at the Swan Falls Wastewater Treatment Plant-Lagoons. Over the last four months, we have seen a combined savings of 43.95% compared to the previous year, amounting to \$6,150.98 so far. After discussing the cost savings with Travis Fleming, the Wastewater Collections Supervisor, he mentioned that he made some system changes to the generators in hopes to decrease cost. This change was made without compromising performance. The graph on the following page better displays the savings trend that we have seen.

We are very happy about this outcome and appreciative of the hard work that the City's employees put forth every day. Their thoughtfulness definitely contributes to making our city operations run so smoothly. I have had the pleasure to work around the water and sewer crew more often and closely, and I have noticed they are all very passionate about what they do, and they do it well.
