



The City of Kuna Arts Commission was formed to promote the City's cultural image, a foundation establishing and maintaining a culturally diverse community artistry experience, enhance art culture for our community, and to acknowledge the importance of arts while benefiting the quality community life and to the local economy.

Call Type: Public Art Proposal - Mural

Entry Deadline: July 1, 2025

Project Budget: \$2,000 including labor, materials, and installation.

- Artist Resume (should include photos of past work and experience)
- Project Proposal and Design Mockup*
- Project Budget (to include labor and materials)

- Images – Minimum: 3, Maximum: 5

Project Information

The Kuna Arts Commission is seeking applications from artists for a mural that will be painted on a power box located behind Kuna City Hall on the Green Belt along Indian Creek. Preference is for proposals that consider the seasons of the Green Belt, wildlife, raptors and birds of prey, geographical and historical highlights of the area, and abstract designs, but others will be considered. The budget for the project will be up to \$2,000 for a unique and eye-catching design to be painted on the power box. The mural will be installed during the Fall of 2025.

The opportunity is open to artists working in all disciplines. The artist must be able to complete the mural within the time frame given. Consideration of the outdoor location of the mural must be taken and reflected in the proposal. The design should be fitting for a community environment, an original artwork, and utilize durable and appropriate materials for continuous outdoor display. The artist will convey copyright to the artwork to the City. Once installed the artwork is expected to last 5 years, though it may be removed or replaced sooner, at the City's



discretion. The Kuna Arts Commission anticipates commissioning one artist but reserves the right to reject all applications.

Approved Mural Location

The selected design for this mural will be chosen for a power box located behind Kuna City Hall. Photos of the site location are provided below. The power box measures approximately 51 inches tall and 33 inches wide. There are four sides and the top of the box that are to be painted. The space behind it is a large grass area where people bring their children and dogs to, play disc golf in, and events take place. This is a scenic location that experiences high levels of foot traffic in the spring and summer time. We ask that artists designing a proposal keep these thoughts in mind.

Applicants Notified: August 8, 2025

Work Must be Completed: September 30, 2025

Applications

Applicants must submit all requirements and media to cityclerk@kunaid.gov or received by personal delivery or mail during regular Kuna City Hall hours to: 751 W. 4th Street P.O. Box 13 Kuna, ID 83634 on or before **July 1, 2025 at 5:00PM MST**. Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.

Selection Process:

The Kuna Arts Commission will review the applications and will make a recommendation regarding the selection of an artist/design for the power box mural project to the Kuna City Council for final approval. The following criteria will be considered when reviewing applications:

- Adherence to the Call to Artists- Public Art Proposal 2025
- Quality of artwork represented in images of past work



- Ability to deliver represented in artist’s resume experience
- Creativity represented in the proposal’s sketch or rendering of design mockup
- Appropriateness of the project in the community

Kuna Arts Commission Responsibilities:

Application review and selection. Recommend an application for approval to the City Council. Coordinate with necessary City Departments for permitting and safety.

Expectations for Selected Artists:

Allow the Kuna Arts Commission to coordinate and oversee the project. Provide project plans, design, and budget. Will enter an agreement for the commissioning of the mural. Complete project work within the required time frame.
